2022 Conference-wide Insurance Program Information Sheet

- This year we will continue with **tier coverage levels to reflect the diversity of our local churches and ministries**. We have, however, opened up exceptions to all tiers. This may enable churches and agencies to lower coverage in certain areas such as replacement value of property, employee benefits liability, business income/extra expense, or be excluded from umbrella liability coverage. Please review all aspects of the insurance program, including the process overview for exceptions. Also review existing (current) coverage details in case updates to your local environment are needed (sale of a parsonage, for example). **Those members who applied for a change in tier coverage and received approval in 2021 will need to submit new request forms for 2022.** Written requests must be received no later than **10/01/21**.
- Questions regarding your tier assignment, building valuations, or to request a review of your tier assignment should be directed to our Account Manager, Pamela Keeser (303-805-3749 pkeeser@churchmutual.com). Montana/Idaho members who were insured with Church Mutual through an agency prior to 01/01/20 should contact their local agent.
- **The requirements for opting out of the Conference-wide program have not changed**. This is a reminder that all members are automatically enrolled in the program unless you submit and receive written approval to opt out. If you received an opt-out approval for 2021, a new request will need to be completed for 2022. Please contact your District Superintendent or Deirdre McGee, Conference Property and Liability Insurance Coordinator, regarding the appropriate request form that is necessary for consideration. Written requests must be received no later than **10/01/21**.
- **Why the 10/01/21 deadline?** The final processing instructions are submitted to Church Mutual on 11/01/21, so we need all requests submitted to the Conference no later than 10/01/21 to allow time for an appropriate review. Information about premiums should be available in September when updated claim data is reviewed.
- Workers' compensation (Colorado and Utah Currently Enrolled in the Program) – Your individual premium is based on payroll/housing of your employees along with our claims experience and rates. Information about premiums should be available in November.
